

WHAT ARE COASTAL HAZARDS?

Coastal Hazards such as flooding, shoreline erosion, storm surge, sea level rise, have the potential to impact infrastructure and environment. DCRM is working at addressing these coastal hazards by regulating shoreline development to minimize risks and impacts to natural processes that protect our coastal areas.

WHY DO WE NEED YOUR INPUT?

Responses collected will be synthesized in an inventory report to drive the update of our Coastal Hazards Area of Particular Concern (APC) for Saipan, Tinian, and Rota. This will inform how we can improve management of coastal hazard areas in the CNMI.
