
CISWMP AT A GLANCE: TINIAN





Ten-year goal found in the CNMI **Comprehensive Sustainable** Development Plan (CSDP):

"By 2030, 50% of the recyclable waste stream will be diverted from CNMI's landfill or RCRA-compliant waste management facilities on Saipan, Tinian, Rota, and the Northern Islands with diverted waste composted, reused, or sold to support sustainable waste management systems."

Of the solid waste currently being landfilled,



~81.6% (~1,142 Tons)



can be diverted, recycled, or composted.

Proposed New Facilities:



Short term— Turn existing open dump site at Puntan Diablo into a Small Community-Exempt Landfill



Expansion of existing Tinian Transfer Station and Recycling Center



Development of a hardfill site for Tinian's construction and demolition (C&D) debris



Long term— construction of a permitted landfill at Atgidon (land within U.S. DoD leaseback area)

Vehicle and scrap metal processing



Recycling programs in offices



Recycling programs in schools



Universal collection—garbage and curbside recycling



Circular Economy—cardboard shredding and composting

The Comprehensive Integrated
Solid Waste Management Plan for
the Commonwealth of the Northern
Mariana Islands (CNMI CISWMP)
was prepared under the leadership
of the Office of the Governor by the
Office of Planning and
Development (OPD) in coordination
with the Department of Public
Works (DPW), the Offices of the
Mayors of Tinian, Rota, Saipan, and
the Northern Islands, the Bureau of
Environmental and Coastal Quality
(BECQ), and the U.S. Environmental
Protection Agency (EPA).

This group of partnering agencies— OPD, DPW, the Offices of the Mayors of Saipan, Tinian and Aguiguan, Rota, and the Northern Islands, BECQ, and EPA— is collectively known as the Inter-Island Solid Waste Management Taskforce.

This public hearing was conducted in accordance with 40 CFR 256.60 , 40 CFR 256.61, and CNMI Public Law 20-20 §20178.
