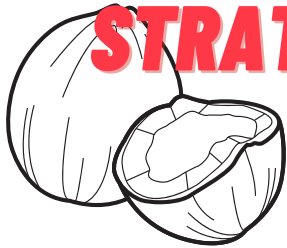
Welcome to YOUR Library! Opened in December 1991, the Joeten-Kiyu Public Library (JKPL) is the CNMI State Library (CNMISL). NMI PL 7-18 established the Commonwealth Library Council (CLC) and Joeten-Kiyu Public Library as the CNMI State Library. As the designated State Library Administrative Agency (SLAA), JKPL oversees the technical aspects of library operations for the Fernando M. Benavente Memorial Library, Bookmobile, Antonio C. Atalig Memorial Library on Rota (RPL) and Tinian Public Library (TPL) in collaboration with the respective mayors of both municipalities, leveraging both annual CNMI government appropriations and federal funds primarily from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS).

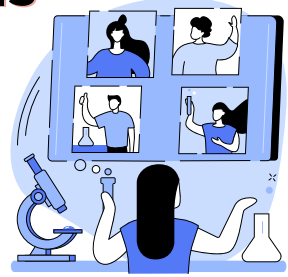

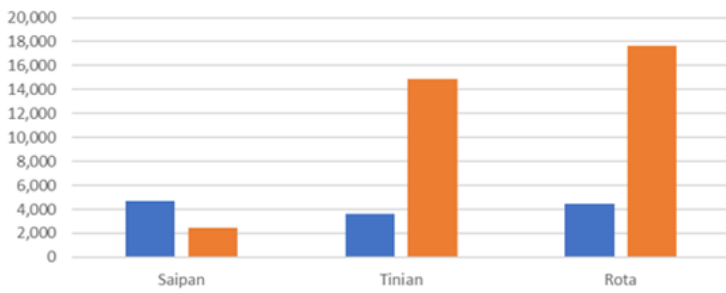

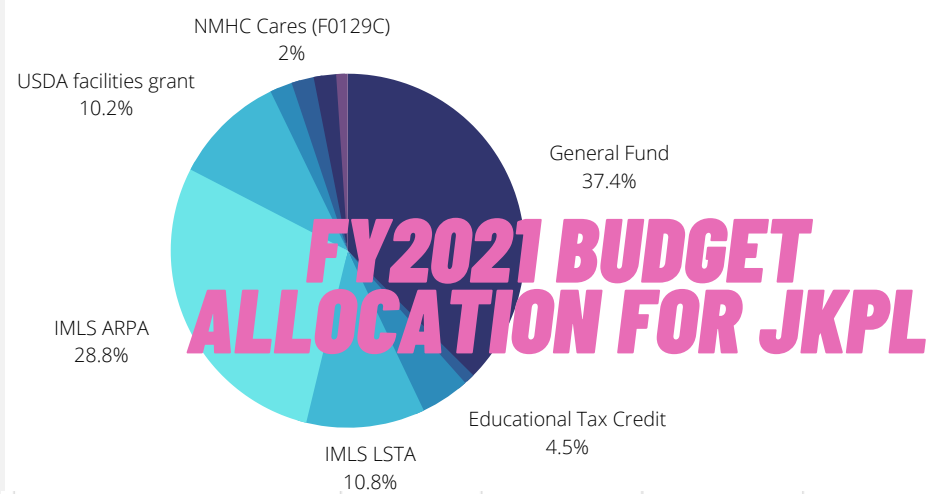

### Major developments of JKPL's FY 2021 Budget include the following:

- Due to the Covid-19 pandemic, local funding for FY2021 was significantly decreased. Personnel budget was allocated \$217,842.00 for 10 employees. As of March 28, 2021, the JKPL reinstated 5 furloughed employees through the assistance of the CARES ACT funding from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) and the Northern Marianas Humanities Council (NMHC) National Endowment for the Humanities. With the Covid-19 pandemic, library programs and services have been limited in order to meet their safe implementation. With the current line of reduced staff and budget, statistics indicates JKPL met challenges in efficiency, customer care, and systematic compilation of performance indicators in line with CNMI State Library LSTA Strategic 5-Year Program Goals: Literate CNMI, 21st Century Skills, and Maintain and Upgrade the CNMISL Technology Infrastructure.
- P.L. 21-35 appropriated \$274,420.00 in local funding for FY2021 JKPL (BU 1592). Funding from IMLS LSTA, IMLS ARPA, and NMHC were used to offset personnel and operations. Through competitive grant sources made available from the Covid-19 pandemic, JKPL aggressively and successfully received additional funding for FY2021.
- Additional donations through the Educational Tax Credit (PL 15-120) assisted JKPL with operational funding support for library programs and activities for Saipan, Tinian, and Rota.
- Utilities budget: As per P.L. 21-35, the total amount allocated for utilities budget is \$43,752.00.
